One-Stop Operator Q & A

- 1. Q. Can you tell me a bit more about who might be a likely agency to do this work? Specifically, I was thinking of folks from the open one of the One Stops? Just looking for a bit more info.
 - A. The purpose of the RFI is to establish, 1 if there are interested service providers in the area and 2 what the range of costs associated with the services is prior to issuing a formal RFP. We believe the services should include the coordination and facilitation of quarterly partner meetings with the intent of working towards aligning services where appropriate. In addition, the One-Stop Operator will work with the Workforce Board or the assigned staff to ensure the partners are working toward building the appropriate system of services/service delivery. In part, the role of the One-Stop Operator will involve enforcement of the partner MOUs. At a minimum, we would expect 1 partner meeting each quarter and the attendance of no less than 2 full Workforce Board or Executive Committee meetings. However, we are interested in all effective methods for systems alignment.
