PIRS is the federal and state designated ILC serving Placer, El Dorado and Alpine Counties since 1995. Our mission is to advocate, empower, educate the community, and provide services that enable people with disabilities to control their alternatives to live as independently as they wish for as long as they are able.

PIRS services include advocacy, peer support, independent living skills training, personal assistants registry and referral, assistive technology resources, information & referral, transition from hospital or institution to community-based living, and transition for youth to successful adulthood.

Independent Living Advocate II will provide services and manage the office. Full time with benefits.

Independent Living Advocate I will provide core services. Part time & limited benefits to begin, increasing to full time at October 1st with full benefits.

Related education & experience is mandatory. Bilingual (Spanish/English) is desirable. Regional travel is a required duty for both positions.
