DESCRIPTION

The Assistant Mechanical Engineer performs a variety of professional mechanical engineering work in connection with the design, construction and inspection of mechanical facilities and installations.

The Assistant Mechanical Engineer Level II is the first working level in this class series. Incumbents are expected to perform with greater independence than at Level I.

The Assistant Mechanical Engineer Level I is the trainee level in this series, designed for recruitment and training of persons who do not meet the minimum qualifications for the first working level (Level II). Incumbents are expected to demonstrate increased proficiency during the trainee period and upon satisfactory completion thereof promote to Assistant Mechanical Engineer Level II.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Either: 1. Graduation from a curriculum in Mechanical Engineering accredited by the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (formerly known as the Engineers Council for Professional Development).

Or: 2. Possession of a valid certificate as an Engineer-in-Training issued by the State of California's Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists (formerly known as the California State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers).
